



## Ann Arbor & Ypsilanti Area Parks

### Nichols Arboretum [View Map](#)

1610 Washington Heights, Ann Arbor, MI 48104  
123 acres of heavily wooded areas including several open fields, wetlands, shrub collections, peony garden, and walking/hiking trails.

### Gallup Park [View Map](#)

2970 Fuller Rd., Ann Arbor, MI 48105-2450  
69 acre park and recreation area. Located along the Huron River and includes scenic walkways, two playgrounds, picnic areas, grills, picnic shelters, a canoe livery, open fields for play, and over three miles of trails for walking and hiking.

### Argo Nature Area and Bandemer Park [View Map](#)

Bandemer Park is a 36.9 acre natural area along the Huron River with dry prairie, open fields, wet forests, wet shrubland, mesic forest, and wet meadow. It includes a disc golf course, grills, picnic areas, trails, and a dirt bike course. Argo Nature Area sits across the Huron River from Bandemer and contains a canoe livery, long riverside trails, and picnic areas.

### County Farm Park [View Map](#)

Washtenaw Avenue and Platt Road, Ann Arbor, Michigan 48104

18-acre Britton Woods Nature Area, a reflection of the Ann Arbor landscape in the pre-settled era. The area was formerly agricultural land, but is now lush with fields, dense hedgerows, brushy cover, and a variety of other wild plant and animal species.

### Delhi Park [View Map](#)

3902 E Delhi, Ann Arbor, MI 48103  
53-acre park situated on the Huron River with picnic areas, a playground, fishing, and softball diamonds.

### Huron River Greenway Trail [View Map](#)

Part of the Border to Border shared path trails project, this trail runs several miles from Dexter to Washtenaw, passing along Ford Lake, Barton Pond, the Huron River, and many parks and nature areas. Many access points with parking and other amenities are located throughout the trail. The trail also runs by St. Joes Hospital in Washtenaw, which separates into several smaller paths easily accessible by those in the area.

### Rolling Hills Park [View Map](#)

7660 Stony Creek Rd, Ypsilanti, MI 48197  
363 acres of wooded areas, open fields, nature trails, and picnic areas. One of the most recreationally diverse parks, Rolling Hills also includes a fishing pond, playgrounds, an 18 hole disc golf course, softball diamond, and a water park with a lazy river and slides.

### Riverside Park [View Map](#)

Canal St, Ann Arbor, MI 48105  
15 acres bordering the Huron River. An accessible asphalt walk connects this park along the river to Broadway and features picnic tables and grills, newly renovated play equipment, a football field, softball diamond and a small gravel parking lot. This section of the river is great for fly fishing, with several areas easy to access.

### Leslie Science and Nature Center Trail [View Map](#)

50 acres of fields, woods, and prairie with several trails and environmental education opportunities at the Nature Center.

### Matthaei Botanical Gardens [View Map](#)

350 acres with four nature trails, woodlands, wetlands, ponds, prairie, outdoor display gardens, and a conservatory.

### Parker Mill Trail [View Map](#)

45 acres with wooded areas, open fields, a mile-long handicap-accessible walking trail (Hoyt G. Post trail), and Sugarbush trail.

### Dexter-Huron Park [View Map](#)

122 acres and situated on the Huron River with woods, a playground, fishing, canoeing, and a softball diamond.

### Independence Lake Park [View Map](#)

Independence Lake County Park offers a multitude of recreational activities for park visitors, and features diverse habitats including wetlands, prairies and great stands of oaks. The summer months feature swimming, boating and fishing, as well as picnicking, hiking, biking and rollerblading.
