Chelsea Community Wellness Trail [View Map](#)

Start point is at Chelsea Community Hospital located at: 775 S Main St, Chelsea, MI 48118
Part of the Rails to Trails collective, this trail runs from the Chelsea Community hospital through open fields and lightly wooded areas through the city.

Timber Town Park

Sibley Rd, Chelsea, MI 48118 (between E. Industrial and M-52)

Features a 12,000 square foot wooden climbing structure, swings, bridges, towers, slides, sandboxes, climbing wall, small spray zone, and much more!
Timber Town serves as a community attraction for families in Chelsea and throughout Michigan. Also includes a large pavilion and expansive open field for various recreations and ball games.

Veterans Memorial Park

Sibley Rd, Chelsea, MI 48118 (between Bush Rd. and W. Industrial)

The park contains a large black marble memorial that pays tribute to those who have served in our armed forces both in peace time and during armed conflicts. The park is also referred to as “Boat Park” because of its large wooden ship play structure. The park also features picnic tables, ball fields and is adjacent to a small stream.

Pierce Park

Pierce Park is often referred to as “the park with the big rock” (which is painted by locals for birthdays and other occasions). The park features a play structure, picnic tables, a pavilion, and plenty of room to run around and play.
